

Decisions of the Management Team May 2010

Decisions of the 123rd MT - 17 May 2010 – ESE 25241

- BT 123-1
(Education)
- As a result of a request from the Student Council of the School Council (SGFR) and in cooperation with the School Council, the following decisions were taken with regards to the mutual ranking of students upon graduation:
- Students, who have completed a certain academic year, have their appraisal (listed with a single digit after the period) compared to a group of students. This group is defined as all students who have completed the same study programme in the previous five academic years.
 - Only students who have completed a full curriculum with less than 30% exemptions may request a ranking.
 - An official diploma (including the plotted graph of the reference group and the ranking of the particular student in this) will be issued upon request and after paying €10.
 - The procedure will on September 1, 2010.
 - A 1-year pilot phase in the OSC to see whether it is feasible and to check whether this method of working can be deployed by the examination board.

Decisions of the 124th MT - 31 May 2010 – ESE 25335

- BT 124-1
(Strategy)
- With regard to inaugural addresses/farewell speeches/PhD defences, the MT has decided the following:
1. The ESE shall bear the costs for printing inaugural addresses and farewell speeches ("the booklet") with a ceiling of €2,000. Recent inaugural addresses will be published retroactively. The Dean's Office (marketing officer) is responsible for the implementation. The PhD-theses are generally published via ERIM/Tinbergen Institute.
 2. If a reception contributes (or partly contributes) to the "growth and expansion" of the ESE, the ESE will provide a financial contribution. The Marketing & Communication section of the Dean's Office will take care of the specific arrangements (for example, special catering and location). In certain cases, this might also concern PhD defences. In the event that security arrangements are needed, the costs shall be reimbursed.
 3. The ESE notifies all employees about each inaugural address, farewell speech and PhD defence. All professors are expected to attend inaugural addresses and farewell speeches. They are notified of the event one month in advance.
